REPORT ON THE BOY SCOUT JAMBOREE::

I just returned from the National Scout Jamboree in West Virginia. K2BSA was active from the Jamboree and over 10% of the youth attending were introduced to Amateur Radio. Additionally, over 300 Scouts earned the Radio Merit Badge. I was proud to be part of that operation. Amateur radio has been a part of the Jamboree experience since at least 1953. K2BSA has been in operation at the Jamboree since 1977. Over that time it has provided demonstrations of amateur radio to thousands of Scouts and helped Scouts earn hundreds of Radio Merit Badges. The 2017 Jamboree operated at the Summit Bechtel Scout Reserve in West Virginia. Additionally, we provided a Foxhunting course with over 100 teams completing the course and launched two balloons carrying APRS. The Jamboree station included four Icom IC-7300s, one IC-7700, one IC-7600, one IC-9100, and one ID-5100. Antennas include DX Engineering supplied Hex Beams and verticals, as well as MFJ, supplied dipoles.
